

Well-Paid Bureaucrats (WPBs)

Every year, the Ontario government publishes the names of all of its civil servants who earned over \$100,000. The complete list can be found [here](#). Listed below is the number of well-paid bureaucrats (WPBs) in Ontario's major Anglophone school boards in 1998 and 2005. The enrolment in most of these school boards is stable or declining, the exception being in the 905 area. The Toronto DSB, for example, lost about 10,000 students during this period, while increasing its WPBs from 73 to 504. The total number of WPBs in these boards increased from 377 in 1998 to 2481 in 2005, an increase of 558%. In 1998, there was approximately one WPB for every 5500 students, while in 2005 it was approximately one per 850.
